

- NEVER dump any chemical, concrete (construction material), grass, etc. into your storm drains (located in the street curb). This will eventually block the storm drain and cause them to back up. Additionally, chemicals flow to our water systems and pollute them! These storm drains are City/County maintained. During a long rain storm, these drains can backup into your streets and yards if they are full of debris.
- When we move into the cooler weather, be sure to check your sprinkler timer and adjust them accordingly. When your landscaping was first installed by TLC, your timer was set to water often so that the plants would establish properly. Once your plants have taken root, you will want to adjust your timer. If your lawn starts to turn yellow, that is a sign of either too much water or not enough fertilizer. If you are not sure, consult your local nursery.
